Policy Statement

Occupational Health and Safety Objectives

Meta Maya Environmental (MME) Management and staff are committed and will make every effort to:

- Prevent and eliminate work-related injuries and illnesses;
- Identify, assess, and control workplace hazards and risks to provide a healthy and safe workplace;
- Develop procedures and instructions to ensure a safe work system is implemented and maintained; and
- Contribute to a positive safety culture in which every employee, contractor and visitor feel free to speak up about non-conformances, undesirable or unsafe situations or any other OHS-related issue.

To achieve our objectives, we will

- Ensure our safety management system conforms to the requirements of relevant legislation, standards, codes of practice and any other client-specific requirements, to include:
 - ISO 45001:2018
 - Work Health and Safety Act 2020 (WA)
- Consult and collaborate with workers to ensure their views and inputs regarding health and safety issues are considered.
- Provide sufficient information, instructions, training, inductions, and supervision to all workers, contractors, and visitors.
- Have a risk-based process in place for identification, classification, and prioritisation to control hazards, risks, and opportunities.
- Establish measurable health and safety targets, report and review our progress to ensure the targets remain relevant through regular review.
- Conduct audits of critical processes to ensure continuous improvement of our occupational health and safety management system.
- Conduct management reviews to regularly engage the methodology of the plan-do-check-act cycle.
