The organisation commenced in 1994 and was set up to service the Housing requirements for the Aboriginal Communities across the Pilbara.



Since inception, PMMRAC has matured and is now an acknowledged professional and quality organisation delivering value added services to the Pilbara communities. The services delivered are based around facility management at Mirnutharntu Maya, Housing Management, Environmental Health and Municipal Services. Meta Maya Services manages the installation and maintenance of essential services i.e. power, water and wastewater infrastructure and Meta Maya Environmental specialises in Asbestos and Hazardous materials.

WORK WITH US

Typical roles available on community include trade positions within Meta Maya Services and Municipal Services, Environmental Health and Housing Officers within PMMRAC.







Trades are required to install and maintain the infrastructure to support the essential services of power, water and wastewater provided to community. Regular trades required are Electricians, Diesel Fitters, Mechanical Fitters and Plumbers.

ROLES

Municipal Services Officers keep communities clean and safe

- Fixing roads, airstrips and firebreaks
- Maintaining parks, playgrounds and sports ovals
- Maintaining landfills and ensuring the community is free from rubbish

Environmental Health Officers strive towards ensuring that the communities are healthier places to live

- Pest Control
- Animal Health
- Educate community members about how the environment affects their health
- Assist in the planning of emergency evacuations for cyclones and bushfires

Housing Officers support community members with their housing requirements and property management

- Checking properties twice a year
- Reporting of repairs and maintenance
